

OCDSB-China Cultural Exchange

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I need to speak Chinese in order to participate?

- a. No. Students do not need to speak Chinese to participate. However, we will offer a few introductory lessons to students interested in learning in the month leading up to our departure.
- b. Students are also encouraged to consider taking Chinese on Saturday mornings through the OCDSB's International and Indigenous Languages Program

2. What is included in the cost of the exchange?

- a. The cost of the exchange includes the following:
 - i. Flights to and from China
 - ii. Mandatory insurance from our travel agent
 - iii. All Chengdu activities and transportation
 - iv. Exchange merch
 - v. All chaperone and administrative costs

b. Not included

i. Shopping / snacks on travel days / souvenirs

c. Payments

i. The payments will be divided into several installments between May and November with the biggest payment coming in May going directly to the travel agent.

3. Where will students stay?

 a. Students will be hosted by the families of students from one of our partner schools in Chengdu. They will stay in a hotel on their first and last night and spend the remaining 7 or 8 nights with their host partners and families.

4. What will students do while in Chengdu?

a. Students will participate in various cultural activities in and around Chengdu (<u>Panda Bear Research Base</u>, <u>Dujianyan</u>, <u>People's Park</u> as well as various activities at elementary, middle and high schools.

5. How often does the exchange run?

- a. The OCDSB-China exchange runs every year in the fall (mid -late November)
- b. There are other exchange opportunities highlighted on our website.

6. What are the timelines of the exchange?

- a. April 1, 2025 Application due
- b. Last week of April students notified of results (accepted or wait list)
- c. May 1st meeting with students
- d. October Pre-departure meeting with parents and students
- e. November Departure to Chengdu
